

### **COVID UPDATE**

- While the restrictions remain at 1 person per 4 square metres, we request that you register your intention to attend worship.
- We encourage you to wear a mask to worship (particularly as you arrive and leave when socially
  distancing is more difficult). While it is not mandatory for the general community to wear a mask it
  is recommended to do so when out in public.
- Singing is permitted but we would request you wear a mask if you are going to sing.
- QR code sign-in. As you will now be aware it is a requirement of the government that we use this
  system where possible. There is the usual paper check-in system available as a backup if
  needed. you will still be required to be 'checked off' to ensure we do not exceed our restricted
  capacity.
- Community sharing please write any prayer request or news item on a piece of paper as you come to church on Sunday and place it in the bowl provided at the door. For the next 2 weeks we will not have 'a roving microphone' during Community Sharing.

#### **KEYS**

Following the theft of valuable sound equipment the decision was made by the Church Council to change the locks on all doors in the church buildings. Going forward there will be a process via an application form (from the office) if you believe it is necessary for you to have a key to the building. Access to keys will be strictly controlled and subject to approval by Church Council who will be considering all applications. You may return your old key to the office for 'recycling'.
