In this story, belief isn't a question of existence. It's a question of putting all of one's eggs in the basket. This is a question we continue to ask as a church, how many eggs do we place in Jesus' basket. Some? Most? All?

- Dianne welcomed all to the meeting.

- Minutes from 6th July had been circulated and were accepted as an accurate record.
- The financial reports for June and July 2021 were accepted.
- Noted that notification today from Synod advising that restrictions regarding COVID protocols for worship this week have not been changed seating as before and singing with masks on.
- The Report on the Playgroup Survey was received from Murray Thompson and briefly discussed.
- Rev. Richard Telfer reported on the first few months of his ministry
- Preliminary discussions about the responses from the Groups regarding input to the Mission Plan for next year onwards.
- Gifted Generosity program is to be held in October. Work is in hand to produce an information brochure, and other documents needed.
- Following discussion, it was agreed that we will hold a Church Picnic in Rydge Park on Sunday 31st
 October after worship all groups of the Church (e.g., Netball Club, Community Shed, Playgroup, mainly
 music) will be invited to attend and members encouraged to bring families.
